All voters are required to present official identification at the polls.

You are eligible to **register and vote** in 2024 elections if you are:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Virginia
- At least 18 years of age or will be by the next general election

VOTER REGISTRATION

Where You may apply online or at the following sites: County Registrar Office, Public Library, Department of Motor Vehicle Offices, Public Assistance Agency offices, i.e., those offering food stamps, aid to dependent children and/or aid to persons with disabilities, etc., Military Recruitment Offices, or District Governmental Centers. For other locations and for more information contact your General Registrar.

When You may register year -round except during the **22 days prior to a general or primary election or 13 days prior to a “stand alone” special election.** Registration will be permanent under most circumstances.

If To remain a qualified voter, you must notify your local voter registration office of any change in your name or address.

ABSENTEE VOTING

Any registered voter may request an absentee ballot.

By Mail or Fax: Absentee ballot application forms are available at the voter registration office or can be downloaded from the voter registration website. A voter can opt to have ballots for future elections mailed, instead of submitting an application for each election. Complete mailed applications must be received by the General Registrar not less than 10 days before an election. Voted ballots returned via USPS must be postmarked by election day and received by the registrar by noon of the 3rd business day after the election.

In Person: Registered voters may vote during early voting at the Registrar’s office beginning 45 days before an election. In-person early voting ends at 5pm on the Saturday before each election.

ratification of the 19th amendment to the U.S. Constitution that gave women

reached after study and member agreement, it is strictly nonpartisan -- it neither
supports nor opposes political parties or candidates for public office.

advocacy.

interested citizens and businesses. Membership is open to men and women
